MATURATION:

Average, at the same time from Golden Delicious

BLOOM:

Slightly later varieties Golden Delicious

PRODUCTIVITY:

- High
- Rapid entry into fruiting
- Low propensity to period of fruiting
- Chemical is effective thinning

FRUIT / PULP:

- Size large
- Has a smooth surface with light lentils
 The flesh is crispy, juicy, fragrant, has a balanced sour-sweet taste

PURPOSE:

Clone of the Golden Delicious variety, grows well in mountainous areas, adapted to the climatic conditions of Northern Europe
