## FRUIT / PULP:

- Size - medium and small
- Shape - conical
- Intense red color color, covering almost everything the surface of the fruit with characteristic strips; fruits are gaining color 3 weeks before the onset of filming maturity.
- The flesh is yellowish, tasty, sweet, crunchy

## SENSITIVITY / RESISTANCE:

- Moderate susceptibility to a number of diseases

## PURPOSE:

A clone of the Gala variety used demand in Northern Europe

## STORAGE:

- In the usual storage - until December
- CA - until March
